

Sandune Archery Club (SAC) 2013 Activities Summary

- SAC hosted tournaments over nine weekends to include the State 900 Round Championship, four 3D tournaments, one Tradition-Only tournament, two Archery for Kids Days and our annual Sandune 500 members and their guests shoot.
- We introduced a Charity 3D tournament which we intend to continue to host annually (Crossways Foodbank). The tournament raised \$1920 for the food bank which will fund its operations for four months.
- Major purchases included replacing our decrepit riding lawn mower, seven mini-genesis bows and 120 arrows, lumber to build our elevated shooting platform, and t-shirts with club logos for selling at concessions.
- We built NASP practice targets for the range and have started building our elevated shooting platform.
- We donated \$390 to help fund Socastee Elementary School's NASP team's trip for participation in the National tournament in Kentucky.
- We assisted Horry County DNR with operating the Horry County NASP tournament.
- We close the year with 110 memberships (family or single) encompassing approximately 250 members.
- We close the year having had 10 paid visitors.
- We had a significant turnover in Board members. We lost 4 Board members (President, Vice President, Social Director, Youth Director) and filled 4 board member positions (President, Vice President, Secretary, Bowhunter Director)
- We introduced a monthly Club Night event for members. This has not been well attended and therefore we will not continue having it next year.
- We added a NASP challenge to our 3D tournaments which has had moderate success.
- We began posting our events in community event calendars which has successfully increased tournament attendance.

- We've determined we'll need to stop using four of our 3D lanes due to safety issues with the Frisbee golf course that popped up behind them.
- We tried to promote archery businesses in the community by working with community archery businesses in offering to host Club nights at their locations.
- We'd like to thank all our members for their support and a special thanks to those who put in so much work to keep the club going this year.
